I, KEVIN J. KENNEDY, Director and General Counsel of the Government Accountability Board, certify that a proposed constitutional amendment was submitted to the people for approval and ratification at an election held on April 1, 2008. The question submitted to the voters reads as follows:

QUESTION 1: “Partial veto. Shall section 10 (1) (c) of article V of the constitution be amended to prohibit the governor, in exercising his or her partial veto authority, from creating a new sentence by combining parts of two or more sentences of the enrolled bill?”

I, FURTHER CERTIFY, that on May 5, 2008, the Chairperson of the Government Accountability Board examined the original returns compiled from the certified statements of the county boards of canvassers and determined that the referendum question was approved by a majority of the electors voting on the question based on the vote totals recorded on the attached statement.
