

## Voter Public Access Web Site (<http://vpa.wi.gov>)



Voter Public Access (VPA) provides a web interface with SVRS to allow the public to verify they are registered to vote, find their polling place location, a list of districts and officeholders, and view a listing of the contests, candidates, and referenda included on their ballot.

### For Registered Voters:

1. Go to the VPA website at <http://vpa.wi.gov>.
2. Under **Lookup Options**, choose number 1, **Look up your voter registration and polling place location**.
3. Enter the **Last Name**, **First Name**, and **Date of Birth**, then click **Search**. One or more matching voter records will appear.

4. Click the **Name** of the correct voter record. A screen will appear showing the voter's **Name**, **Residential Address**, **Mailing Address**, **Voter Registration Number**, **Date of Birth**, **Registration Date**, and **Status**.

Searching by name requires a last name, first name, and date of birth. You must use the name that was used at the time of registration (i.e. no nicknames). If you do not find the record you are searching for, try variations of the name. This may be necessary if your last name includes special characters or spaces (e.g. Van Klevé, O'Neill, Hebden-Lloyd). Some voters did not provide a date of birth when they registered and are listed on Voter Public Access with a default date of birth of 1/1/1900. If you do not find the record you are searching for, try the search using a date of birth of 1/1/1900.

**View voter information by clicking on your name**

5. Click **View your Voter History** to see a list of elections that this voter has voted in.
6. Click **Return to Voter Information** to exit the **Voting History** screen.



*Note: Voter history should be accurate starting in November of 2006, when the entire state started using SVRS to record voter participation. Voting history before that was converted in from another database, and may not always be accurate.*

7. The **Voter Information** screen will also list any **Active Election**, the **Polling Place Location** and **Hours**, all the **Districts** the voter lives in, and the **Office Holders** in those districts.
8. If an election is coming up soon, you can click **View Sample Ballot** to see the contests and candidates on the ballot.

## For Non-Registered Voters:

1. Go to the VPA website at <http://vpa.wi.gov>.
2. Under **Lookup Options**, select **Look up polling place location for an address**.
3. Enter the **House Num**, **Street Name**, and **City**, then click **Search**.



If you are unsure of how the street is named in SVRS, you can enter part of the street name. For example, if you live on County Road Z, try entering just "Z" in the street name. All streets in that city with a Z in the street name will appear.

4. Click on the blue **Street** in the correct address range.
5. An **Address Information** screen will open, showing the **Polling Place Location**, link to **View Sample Ballot, Districts**, and **Office Holders**, as described above.

Mailing addresses, including all PO Box addresses, will not return any results. If you do not find the record you are searching for, try variations of the street name. This may be necessary if you live on a county highway (e.g. Cty Hwy X, CTH X) or state road (e.g. State Rd 1, SR 1).
