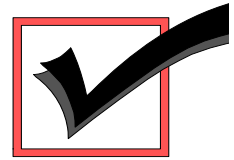


BALLOT ACCESS CHECKLIST



FOR 2010 FEDERAL CANDIDATES IN WISCONSIN

Each of the following forms must be completed and filed on time by a candidate for federal office in order for the candidate's name to be placed on the ballot for the September 14, 2010 Partisan Primary and the November 2, 2010 General Election in Wisconsin.

Circulate and submit ***Nomination Paper for Partisan Office (Form GAB-168)*** to the Government Accountability Board, Elections Division no later than **5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, July 13, 2010**. Nomination papers may not be circulated before June 1, 2010. §8.15(1), Wis. Stats.

The number of signatures required are as follows:

United States Senator	2,000 – 4,000
Representative in Congress	1,000 – 2,000



Complete and submit a ***Declaration of Candidacy (Form GAB-162)*** to the Government Accountability Board, Elections Division no later than **5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, July 13, 2010**. This form must be filed with the Elections Division by July 13, 2010 or the candidate's name will not be placed on the ballot. §§8.15(4)(b), 8.21, Wis. Stats.
