

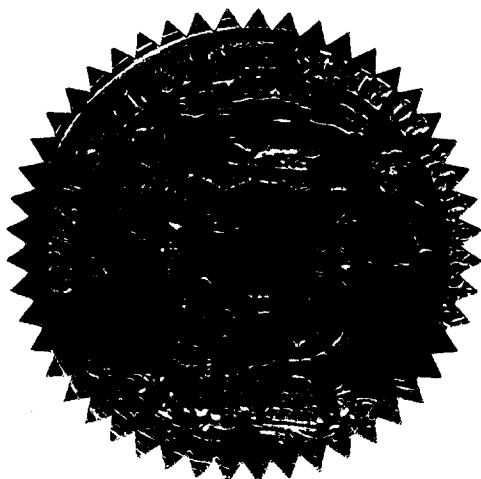


EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 9


Relating to a Special Election for the Thirty-Third Senate District

WHEREAS, the Honorable Margaret Farrow submitted her resignation as a State Senator for the thirty-third Senate District, effective May 9, 2001;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott McCallum, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to section 8.50(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, order that a special election be held on July 10, 2001 to fill the vacancy in the thirty-third Senate District. A description of the boundaries of the thirty-third Senate District as created in *Prosser et. al. v. Elections Board et. al.*, 793 F.Supp. 859 (W.D. Wis. 1992) is set out in the 1999-00 Wisconsin Statutes following section 4.009(33). The term will expire on the first Monday in January, 2003 and, if a primary is necessary, it shall be held June 12, 2001. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on May 9, 2001 and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 P.M., May 15, 2001. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
